



Quicksilver – 8.2 or 9.5

- Protect a 3' aisle opening.
 - Older style “swept” system
 - Phased out by May '99
 - Chrome loops
 - Replaced by the QS2000 in 1999.
 - Difference between Quicksilver and QS2000:
 - Quicksilver has 1 crossbar and the electronics component is taller than the QS2000's.

QS2000 – 8.2 or 9.5

- Protect 3' aisle opening.
 - Integrated alarm lamp & sounder (in RX)
 - Difference between QS2000 and Quicksilver:
 - QS2000 has 2 crossbars and the electronics component is shorter than the Quicksilver's.
 - Think of QS2000 = 2 crossbars
 - Single aisle QS2000 replaced by Liberty in the QX3 configuration.
 - Dual Aisle QS2000 replaced by Liberty in the QX5 configuration.

SIGNATURE – 8.2 or 9.5

- Is a Quicksilver or QS2000 in wood.
 - The same differences tell them apart.
 - Oak wood package
 - Finished or unfinished
 - Protect 3' opening
 - Integrated alarm sounder (in RX)
 - Compatible with all accessories but the People Counter.
 - Single aisle replaced by using two Liberty EX-Plus.
 - Dual aisle replaced by using three Liberty EX-Plus.

QS4000 – 8.2

- White plastic, looks like a Strata
 - Is a “swept” system like Quicksilver and QS2000.
 - Protect 4' opening
 - Integrated alarm lamp & sounder (in RX)
 - Compatible with all accessory items.
 - Difference between QS4000 & Strata:
 - QS4000 has 2 crossbars and Strata has 3 crossbars
 - Single aisle replaced by Liberty PX3
 - Dual aisle replaced by Liberty PX5

STRATA – 8.2

- White plastic, looks like a QS4000.
- Is a “transceiver system”:
 - One sensor protects 3' on either side
 - 2 Sensors cover 12' - with 6' “clear” aisle
 - Each sensor has integrated alarm lamp & sounder
- Difference between QS4000 & Strata:
 - Strata has 3 cross bars and QS4000 has 2 crossbars
- Strata PX single wide aisle (total 12' coverage) replaced by Liberty PX2.
- Strata PX multiple aisle (total 18') replaced by combining a Liberty PX1 with a PX2.



QS6500 – 8.2

- 5' "swept" system
- 8.2 only
- Some may have been converted to "pulse/listen" transceiver by upgrading with a special Strata upgrade kit.
- Replaced with Strata PX
- You may see a few.
- No longer supported (European system sourced from an outside company as a means to offer a wide-aisle system in mid 90's)
- **OBSOLETE. UPGRADE CANDIDATE. PARTS NO LONGER AVAILABLE.**



QS1500/1501/1600 – 1.8 system only

- Hard tag only system
 - Apparel stores
 - One sensor protects 3' to either side
 - 2 sensors cover 12' - with 6' "clear" aisle
 - Low profile antennas - Wood or Chrome package
- 1.8 mhz hard tags still available for reorder.
- Works great..very stable system, 1.8 technology goes back many years. Happy customers.
- The only real reason a customer would upgrade is to start using deactivatable labels..or the system can't be repaired
- Additional antennas to expand a system or cover an additional entrance are not available.
- Instead, you will want to upgrade this customer to a Liberty DX system capable of using both 1.8 and 8.2 hardtags as well as 8.2 labels and deactivation.



DEACTIVATION

- Chassis will be a black or dark gray box of varying sizes depending on version with a cable extending to one possibly two two deactivation pads, and a power cord connecting to an outlet.
- The pad cable may be hard wired to chassis or some type of plug-in.
- The version is identified on the front of the chassis by a roman numeral II, IV, V, VII or IX. (CP2, 4, 5, 7 or 9.
- CP2 was obsoleted long ago, not supported. Must be replaced.
- Some CP4 parts obsoleted in 2005. Should consider it obsoleted and suggest it be upgraded. Availability of parts cannot be guaranteed if a service call is made.
